 - Cash is still safe in the ATM



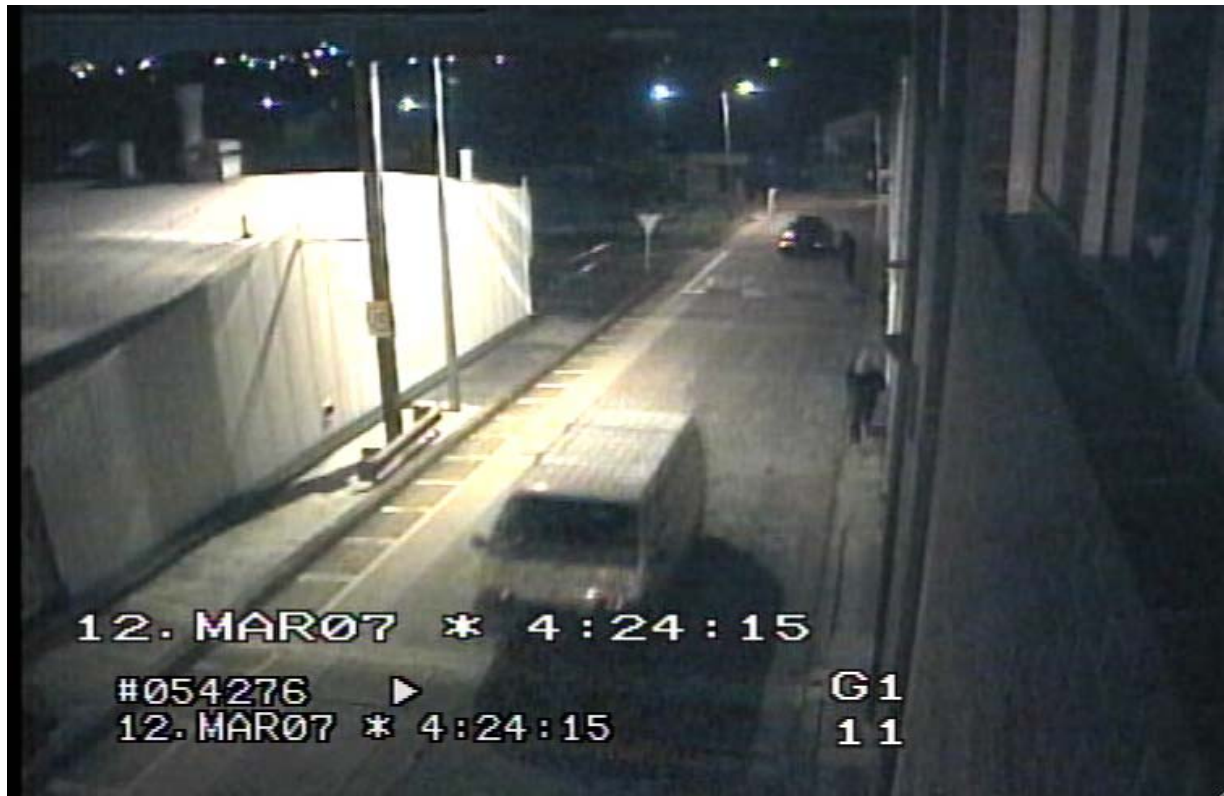
Case Study

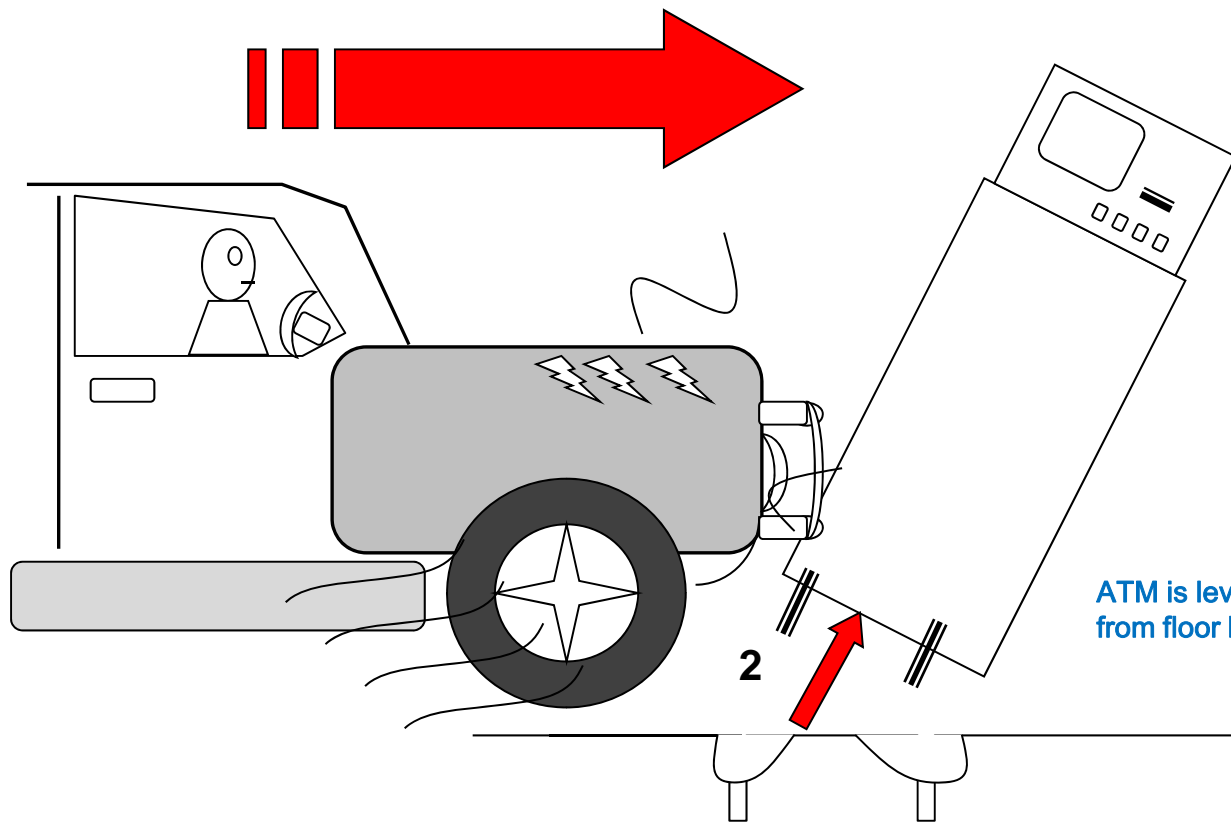

Existing Floor Bolt Technology



ATM is levered up and out as concrete breaks away from floor bolts.

Raminator Holds When Bolts Don't

The floor bolts for this ATM were torn from the ground by the vehicle's impact. The ATM Raminator anchor bolts remained intact.

The ATM and cash are still secure.
